Attorney Roger Thomas representing the applicant opened the hearing explaining that the applicant was seeking to amend site plan to include the use of the of the small building in the front of the property. Mr. Thomas explained that a waiver of site plan was accepted on the larger building in August of 2019 and the applicant has decided that they will commence renovation on the smaller building for similar use as additional education space.

The applicants were sworn in and testified to the following. Mr. Eric Lindquist is owner and operator of the facility and his sister Donna Denny is the business administrator. The business operates to teach techs to utilize the ultrasonic equipment. The business operates from Monday through Sunday from 8 a.m. to 9 p.m. Weekend work would be mostly training sessions. They have three/four full time employees, but mostly only two at a time in the office. Class sizes are about 10 to 15 people due to Covid, but Mr. Lindquist testified that they have a capacity of up to 30 people but they typically only have about 24. He continued to report that they have "outgrown" the first building and need to use the second building mostly for training. He stated that they have not intentions of expanding the operations or changing signage.

A MOTION by Mayor Morgan, seconded by Mr. Pearson to approve the application as submitted and testified. Upon roll call the following votes were cast: AYES: Walter, Morgan, Pearson, Brothman, Daschko, Breitz. NAYS: None. Motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS: Mrs. Daschko asked the Mayor if snow removal on borough streets were a possibility after the recent three-foot snow banks have made the roads very narrow.
